ORDINANCE, RULES, REGULATIONS

for

Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery

1. Title

This ordinance shall be called as "The Rama University Uttar Pradesh, Faculty of B.A.M.S. is a five-year undergraduate program that offers an integrated course that covers a wide range of subject of traditional Ayurveda and modern medical system, the five and half a year long course also include the one-year mandatory internship.

2. Duration of the Course

S.No	Course of the BAMS Program	Duration
1.	First Professional BAMS	Eighteen Months
2.	Second Professional BAMS	Eighteen Months
3.	Third Professional BAMS	Eighteen Months
4.	Compulsory Rotatory Internship	Twelve Months

- i. The Course shall consist of regular study for a minimum period of (Four & Half with One YearInternship) yearly.
- ii. The course of study shall be by regularly attending the requisite number of lectures, tutorials and practical training.

3. Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction for the program shall be Sanskrit or Hindi or English.

4. Number of seats

The One Hundred Number of students to be admitted each year and the number of batches shall be decided and notified by the NCISM & Ministry of AYUSH from time to time; based upon the Rules, instructions and Notifications issued by the University.
