The question papers shall be set and evaluated by the concerned Department/Specialty. The candidates shall have to secure a minimum of 50% in the Basic Sciences and shall have to pass the Part-I examination at least six months prior to the final (Part-II) examination.</p> <p>Part-II: Shall consist of three papers, namely:- (ii) Practical and Clinical Examination; Viva-voce; and (iv) Pedagogy.</p> <p>SCHEME OF EXAMINATION: Theory: Part-I: Basic Sciences Paper - 100 Marks Part-II: Paper-I, Paper-II & Paper-III - 300 Marks (100 Marks for each Paper) Practical and Clinical Examination: 200 Marks Viva-voce and Pedagogy : 100 Marks Written examination shall consist of Basic Sciences (Part-I) of three hours duration shall be conducted at the end of First year of MDS course.
