

The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.







Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the assessment of the physical and the teaching facilities available for renewal of permission for admission of 4th batch of MBBS students and also request for grant of Letter of Permission for proposed increase of seats from 100 to 150 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2011-2012 at Rama Medical College Hospital & Research Centre, Kanpur, U.P. under Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar University, Agra was carried out by the Council's Assessors on 15th & 16th February, 2011. The assessment reports were considered by the Board of Governors and noted that there are minor deficiencies with regard to renewal of permission for admission of 4th batch of MBBS students and therefore decided to renew the permission for admission of 4th batch of 100 (one hundred only) MBBS students for the academic year 2011-2012. The Board of Governors further decided that the college authorities may submit the compliance in this regards before next renewal of the college will be considered. The Permission is, however, subject to the condition that admission process may be completed as per time schedule prescribed in the Regulations of Medical Council of India.

Regarding, request for grant of Letter of Permission for proposed increase of seats from 100 to 150, the Board of Governors decided not to issue LOP for the proposed increase of seats from 100 to 150 for the academic session 2011-2012 due to infrastructural deficiencies & inadequate clinical material for training 150 students.

In addition to above, this is further to inform you that while making admissions of your college to MBBS course it shall be ensured that:


- (i) No admission is permitted beyond the sanctioned intake capacity;
