The feedback analysis committee of the University designs and collects feedback from students to monitor and evaluate its performance quality on curriculum and curriculum related issues.

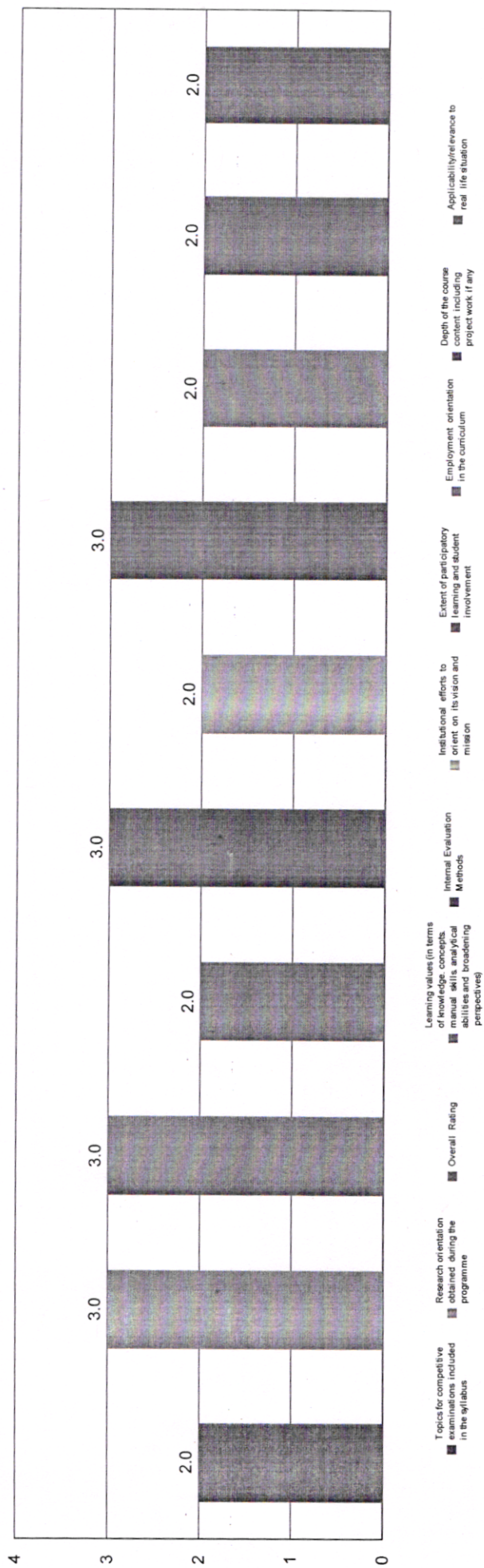
This undergraduate feedback was focused on only curriculum, syllabi, teaching and learning.,

S.No	FEEDBACK	ACTION TAKEN
1.	Students expressed concerns regarding the clarity of teaching in certain courses, especially in legal theory and constitutional law.	Invited guest lecturers from the legal profession to conduct workshops and practical sessions.
2.	Students expressed a desire for more opportunities in moot court competitions, internships, and involvement with legal aid clinics.	The law school partnered with more organizations and firms for internship placements. A committee was formed to organize additional moot court competitions and legal aid activities throughout the semester.
3.	The condition of some classrooms and lecture halls was reported to be insufficient, with inadequate seating and poor ventilation.	The maintenance department worked on refurbishing the affected classrooms and installing better ventilation systems. New seating arrangements and updated multimedia equipment were installed in several lecture halls.

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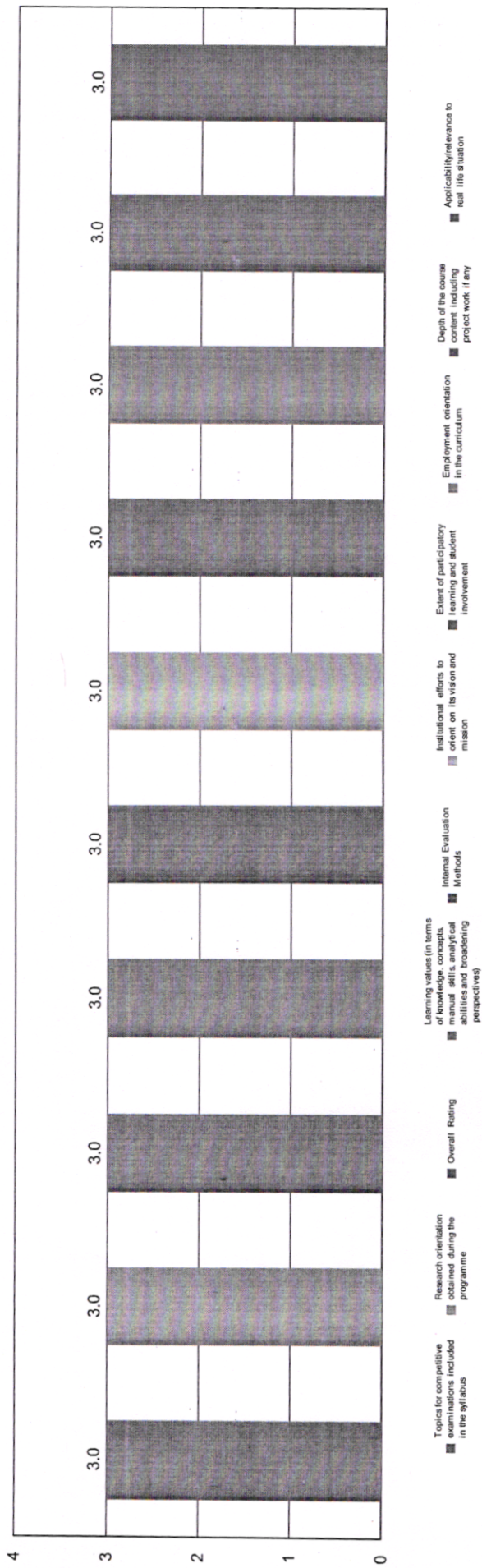

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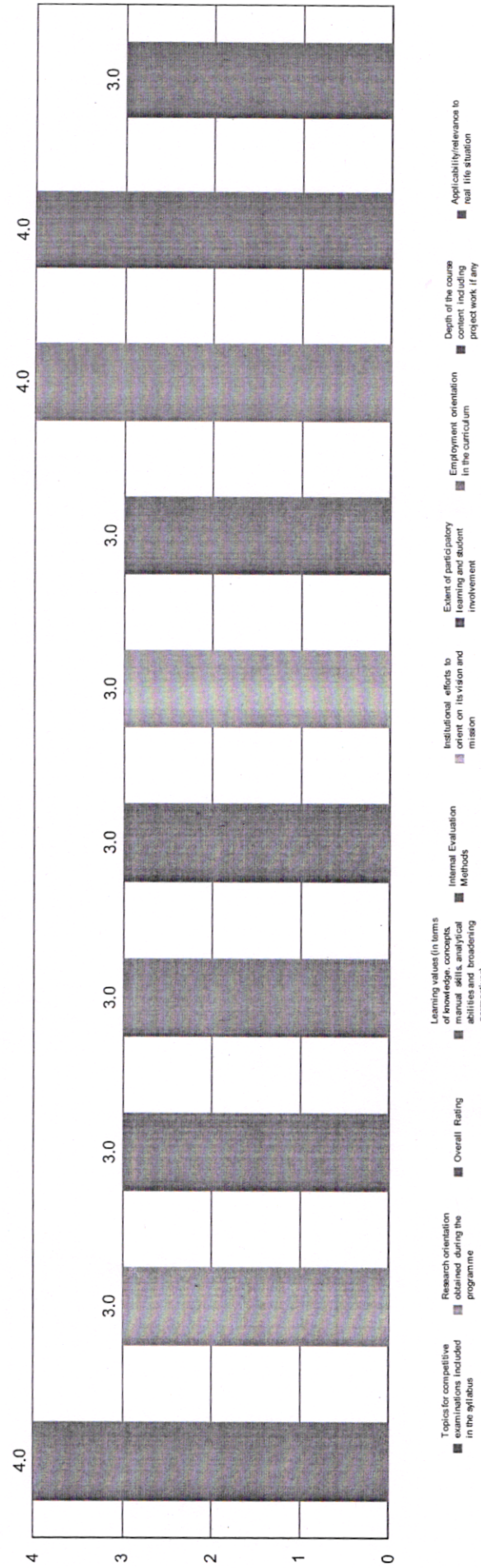
