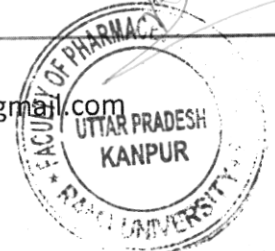
The feedback analysis committee of the University designs and collects feedback from students to monitor and evaluate its performance quality on curriculum and curriculum related issues.

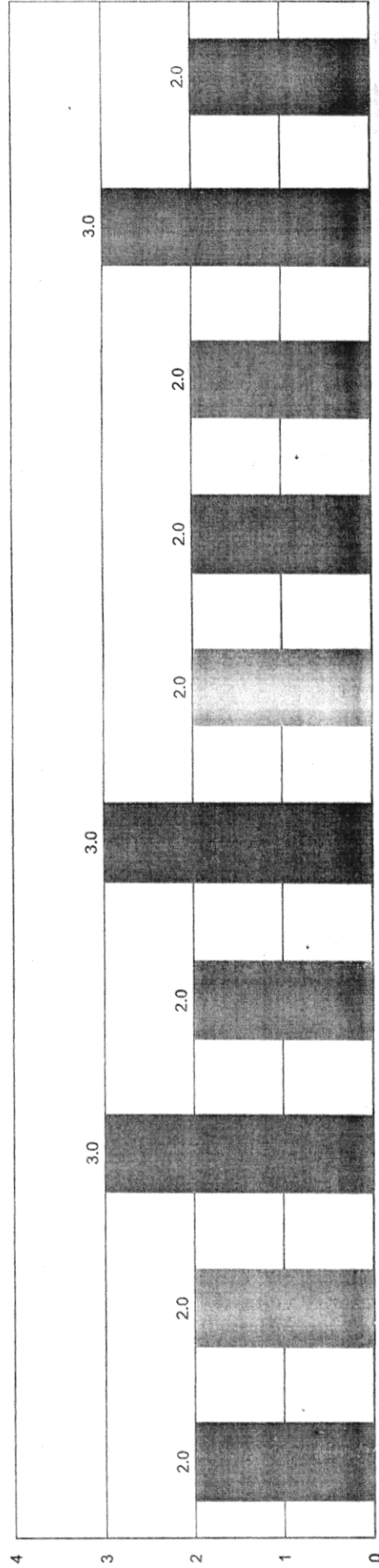
