Minutes of Meeting

The Chairperson welcomed the members and the following points were discussed in the meeting:

Agenda 01: Review of the activities during October-December, 2024

Dean FET apprised the members that on 9th November, 2024 the Department of Biotechnology facilitated an enriching industrial visit of students to Mohan Goldwater Breweries in Unnao; 6th International Conference on Artificial Intelligence & Robotics in Life Science (ICAR-2024) was organized on 22-23 November, 2024

Dean-FPHS informed that 2nd National Current Good Manufacturing Practice (cGMP) Day was organized on 10 October, 2024; a Health Check-up & Awareness Program was organized on 18th December, 2024 under the Uttar Pradesh Government's flagship *Mission Shakti Phase-5*, aimed at empowering women and promoting gender equality.
